Manages the planning, design and construction of rural power systems, including diesel power plants, bulk fuel tank farms, renewable energy systems, and power distribution systems. Provides technical assistance to rural Alaska communities in order to support the safe and reliable operation and maintenance of bulk fuel tank farms, electrical power generation and distribution systems, and renewable energy systems.

Responsible for project planning, collecting and analyzing energy and community data, identifying present and future needs, conceptualizing engineering solutions, and developing, reviewing, and analyzing plans and proposals in order to determine the feasibility and appropriate technology for a prospective project. Conducts site visits and public meetings in order to discuss prospective projects with local entities and residents.

- Minimum of 10 years of experience in the construction, operations, and maintenance of Rural Alaska Power and Bulk Fuel Systems required
